From time to time I have been asked about the location of the 'shortcut' off The Tors back to Errwood Hall. Not always obvious and a wrong choice will always lead you over very difficult terrain with deep tussocks.

This is a handy option if someone gets tired on a circular route. Also handy as a safe harbour in the event the weather changes suddenly to gales and snow storms in winter. Interesting anyway as a diverse route in season for hunting insects.

The turnoff is 975 metres from Shining Tor if you have GPS. It has traditionally been signposted by a couple of flat stones wedged into the wire fence and/or a small cairn of stones piled at the entrance to the route; someone has a habit of sabotaging those markers.

Opposite the route a 10 metre section of drystone wall is completely absent. But there is an arrow carved into a wooden fence post. The clough starts at the red dots where relative shelter is assured.
