

This is a handy option if The Street is closed (to traffic) at the Goyt Valley, as happens from time to time, especially in snow and icy conditions. It means doing the uphill bit last rather than first as I prefer.

Start at Pym Chair car park (SJ 994 767 – Elev: 475m), the large red dot, and follow the trail towards Shining Tor.

Unless you decide to 'nip' up to Shining Tor (add 1.95km), you turn left off The Tors at the blue dot. That leads to the Unnamed Clough (see PDF on the Unnamed Clough if you are not familiar with the area).

This winding and interesting route is sheltered and leads directly back to Errwood Hall car park (SK 012 748 – Elev: 295m).

Take the road back to Pym Chair either on grass tracks or on tarmac. Grass tracks recommended if the roads are icy, usually above 300 metres elevation in winter.

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Distance: 7.6km (GPS)
